Fort Pitt Grammar School – Criteria for application for a Bursary for students of Exceptional Ability and Aptitude (EAA)

Our aim is to offer financial assistance to the parents/carers of students on the EAA Register of students of who would not otherwise be able to afford some of the opportunities available. Each application will be considered on its own merits. An application does not unfortunately guarantee receipt of any monies.

It is our hope that by making available small bursaries, students of EAA at Fort Pitt will be able to benefit from extension activities which might enthuse and motivate them in subjects which may or may not be directly related to the curriculum. We believe that self-esteem and confidence are also likely to be increased when students become involved in this type of extra-curricular activity and therefore wish to encourage our students in this way.

Criteria

- Students must be on Fort Pitt Register and recognised as of Exceptional Ability or Aptitude in one or more curriculum areas

Desirable Criteria

(one or more may apply – please enter this information on the application form)

- Eligible for Free School Meals
- Claiming Free School Meals
- One parent family
- Parent(s) unemployed
- Looked after child (LAC)
- Families with multiple school-age children (four or more)
- Other special circumstances (this will need to be clarified on the application form)
