MEASLES OUTBREAKS IN ENGLAND IN 2018.

I am forwarding you some information recently circulated by Public Health England regarding the Measles outbreaks in England in 2018.

As you may be aware there has been an increase in the number of children and adults contracting measles and schools have been asked to raise awareness of the MMR vaccine and encourage people to get vaccinated.

If you think that you or a family member have been in contact with someone with measles you are advised to phone your GP and NOT visit them to seek advice.

There is no upper age limit for having the free MMR vaccine, so if you are not sure if you and your children received two doses of MMR, you should contact your GP for clarification.
