Year 9 Enrichment Day

At Fort Pitt we offer a wide range of enrichment activities to our students throughout the year. These extra-curricular activities provide our students with an opportunity to learn skills or enjoy activities which go beyond the standard school curriculum.

As part of the Year 9 programme, we run an Enrichment Day to introduce students to new activities and hopefully encourage them to take an active role in them in the future. Events such as this broaden students' perspectives, help them realise new talents and allow them to develop transferable skills that enhance their employability in the future.

The school is using its Enrichment budget to cover the majority of the funds required, but we are also asking parents for a voluntary £5 contribution in order to confirm the wide range of activities we hope to be able to provide on this day. This discretionary contribution will make it possible to offer students exciting sessions that spark their imagination and go beyond what is possible using school resources alone.

The Enrichment Day will take place on Monday 9 July from 8:30 a.m. to 3.00 p.m. It includes sessions on Crime psychology, Team-building with the Challenger Troop, Gingerbread making, Cheerleading, Japanese culture and more.

We would also like to invite parents to experience the day too, giving you the chance to experience life at Fort Pitt first-hand. Within a team of parents, you will follow the programme for the day and engage in all of the tasks; some creative, some physical and of course some thinking! If you would like to be involved on the day, we ask that you consider contributing the same amount as we suggest for each student to cover resources, as well as the lunch which we will provide for you.

Please return the completed reply slip attached to this letter and, if you are able, the £5 donation, placed in an envelope with your daughter's name, form and event written clearly on the outside. This should be given to the Main Office between 8.10 a.m. and 8.25 a.m. or during morning break by Monday 2 July. Cheques should be payable to Fort Pitt Grammar School. If cash is given it is your daughter's responsibility to collect a receipt from the Main Office. Alternatively payment may be made via Parentpay.
